

Application Process

- Submit a Traditional Undergraduate Application online for free at www.IndianaTech.edu/ApplyNow.
- Schedule a campus visit or sign up to attend a Transfer Tuesday event at www.IndianaTech.edu/Visit.
- Submit ACT/SAT test scores and transcripts from your high school and all colleges you have attended to our Office of Admissions.
 - Student-athletes must register for a student-athlete profile through the NAIA Eligibility Center at playNAIA.org and submit high school and college transcripts to the Center.
 - Students who have earned an associate or bachelor's degree are not required to submit a high school transcript or ACT/SAT scores.
 - Students who have earned a GED must submit a score report or transcript.
- Submit the FAFSA with our code, **001805**, online at FAFSA.ed.gov by April 15.
 - Visit IndianaTech.edu/Calculator to estimate your academic scholarship and financial aid award package using our net price calculator.
- Check your application folder and admissions status online at my.IndianaTech.edu.

After Acceptance

- Review transfer credit evaluation through the Degree Audit Portlet on my.IndianaTech.edu.
 - All college transcripts are required to complete a credit evaluation.
- Review your financial aid offer online at my.IndianaTech.edu
 - Accept your financial aid awards
 - Complete your To-Do List items
- Submit your \$100 tuition deposit at IndianaTech.edu/Deposit. This action confirms your plan to enroll.
- Pay your \$350 housing deposit online at IndianaTech.edu/Deposit if you plan to live on campus.
 - Within 24-72 hours after your housing deposit is processed you can apply for housing at IndianaTech.edu/Housing.
- Send your final official college transcript at the end of your last semester to the Office of Admissions in order to complete your final credit evaluation.
 - Student-athletes must also submit a final official college transcript to the NAIA Eligibility Center.
- RSVP for New Student Registration online at IndianaTech.edu/Events.
 - Transfer students can only register for classes during the months of January, June, July, and August.

Clearing Process

- Complete any remaining To-Do List items for Financial Aid online at my.IndianaTech.edu.
- Review your billing statement and complete all necessary billing items on My Account tab of my.IndianaTech.edu.
- Obtain your student ID at the security desk in Andorfer Commons.
- Visit the bookroom in the Warrior Fieldhouse to sign your textbook rental agreement and pick up your books.
