## TRANSFER CHECKLIST

## Application Process ------

- Submit a Traditional Undergraduate Application online for free at IndianaTech.edu/ApplyNow.
- Schedule a campus visit or sign up to attend a Transfer Tuesday event at IndianaTech.edu/Visit.
- Submit your final official high school/GED transcript to the Office of Admissions.
  - · High School transcript isn't required if you have already earned an associate or bachelor's degree.
- Submit an official transcript from any and all colleges attended.
- Student-athletes must register for a student-athlete profile through the NAIA Eligibility Center at play.myNAIA.org and submit high school and college transcripts there.
- Submit your FAFSA with our code, 001805, online at FAFSA.ed.gov by April 15.
- Check your application folder for missing items and admissions status online at Apply.IndianaTech.edu/Status.

## After Acceptance

- Review your transfer credit evaluation, which will be sent to you via email once an admission decision has been processed.
  - All college transcripts are required to complete a credit evaluation.
- Review the financial aid offer and cost breakdown, which will be mailed to you.
- Submit your \$100 tuition deposit at IndianaTech.edu/Deposit. This action confirms your plan to enroll.
- Pay your \$350 housing deposit online at IndianaTech.edu/Deposit if you plan to live on campus.
  - Within 24 to 72 hours after your housing deposit is processed you can apply for housing through the Residence Life portal under 1-Click Apps on **letmein.IndianaTech.edu**.
- Send your final official college transcript at the end of your last semester to the Office of Admissions in order to complete your final credit evaluation.
  - Student-athletes must also submit a final official college transcript to the NAIA Eligibility Center.
- RSVP for Become IT online at IndianaTech.edu/Events.

#### Clearing Process

- Complete outstanding items on your Financial Aid To-Do list online at my.IndianaTech.edu.
- Review your billing statement and complete all necessary billing items on My Account tab of my.IndianaTech.edu.
- Register your vehicle for a parking permit online at IndianaTech.edu/Permits.
- Obtain your student ID at the security desk in Andorfer Commons.
- Visit the bookroom in the Warrior Fieldhouse to sign your textbook rental agreement and pick up your books.
